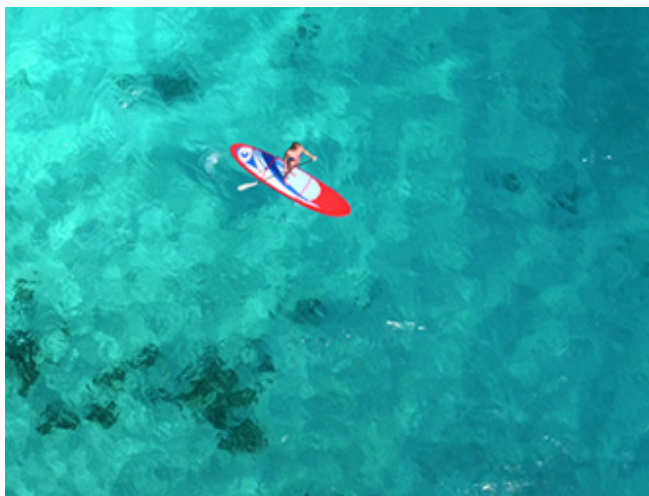




Our Best of 2020: Leadership Between Two Worlds
